2016 Fossil Collecting

Saturday, Apr 16

Between lousy weather and other commitments, my spring collecting has been very slow. I did manage to sneak away to Hungry Hollow, but the collecting was far from great. As usual, I focused my efforts in the South pit. I made what I believed to be one of my most thorough searches of that pit, at least in the Hungry Hollow formation, but most of what I gathered up was pretty common. No trilobites or blastoids this trip, but I think I did manage to add at least one new brachiopod species to my collection. As I was beginning to make my way

out, I was able to cross a piece off of my "must find" list. In the clay, likely having rolled down from the higher levels, was a small fragment of a horn coral. I must have seen hundreds if not thousands of similar sized pieces today as they are literally everywhere, but this one was a bit different. It wasn't the coral I cared about, but what was on it —a Hederella bryozoan colony that wraps all the way around. It certainly takes a specialist collector to appreciate things like this, and that must be what I am because I was quite happy to find it.

Not much of a report this month, but hopefully with a spring Bowmanville trip (WOOHOO!!!!), I will have plenty to write about for the next issue.
